A Healthy Homes Coordinator from Revitalize CDC will visit your home to check for things that might affect the air quality and your health.

A Healthy Homes Coordinator will bring supplies to your home and show you how to use them to help reduce possible triggers. This can help prevent trips to the doctor or hospital. Your Healthy Homes Coordinator will also check the environment and might suggest services to improve the air quality in your home, like fixing mold, cleaning ducts and vents, or controlling pests

Participants may be eligible for:

- Air purifier
- Mattress protector
- HEPA vacuum
- Dehumidifer
- Green cleaning supplies
